
LCD-B Instructions

LCD Button Instructions



Brightness Adjustment

Press" set "button into backlight adjustment mode.



Adjust brightness through " \uparrow " button and " \downarrow " button.

Five brightness levels are available at disposal.

Wheel Diameter Setting

Press "Set" button for six seconds into wheel diameter setting mode. (for the vehicle assembly worker). It is shown as follows:



When shown as , change wheel diameter and the perimeter of rim through "↑"button and "↓"button.

Setting the range of the wheel diameter :16 $^{\prime\prime}$ \sim 28 $^{\prime\prime}$ (different perimeter of the rim can be selected with the same wheel diameter). Unit of the perimeter of the rim : mm.

With no further button operation within 5 seconds, the system would automatically exit "Set" mode and return back into normal working mode.

Press "Set" button and " \downarrow " button simultaneously to display error code, which indicates the malfunction of the system due to the systematic error.

Assistance Adjustment

" † " button: enhance assist;

" ↓ " button: weaken assist;

Six levels are available at disposal.



Press "↓" button until "Auto" icon is shown, the Auto Mode is shown as follows:



Riding Mileage & Time Display

Press "Set" button into Trip Distance Display mode(MILE/KM)



Press "↓" button to clear data

Press "Set" button again into trip riding time display mode

Press "↓" button to clear data

Press"↑"button and"↓"button simultaneously for about six seconds to switch the display between Kilometer and Mile, including the speed of riding, trip distance and ODO.


